Now Hear This with the Hallé Orchestra is a unique concert specially designed to offer children on the Whole Class Ensemble Teaching programme the opportunity to play and sing with an international symphony orchestra at the Royal Concert Hall, Nottingham.

Working with schools through the **Inspire Nottinghamshire Music Hub**, Now Hear This with the Hallé is a concert for Key Stage 2 children singing or learning a musical instrument at Primary Schools, Independent Schools or in Home Education.

You will receive free resources in advance of the concert to have fun in your music classes, make Model Music Curriculum links and prepare the pupils for the concert visit.

After you have booked your tickets, we'll send you the password to access the resources from the Nottinghamshire Music Hub web site.

There are two ways you can take part:

Come and Play

If your school is taking part in Whole Class Ensemble Teaching (WCET) and/or you have young musicians, then your players can join the Hallé in the performances of **Sousa's *Liberty Bell*** and **Bernstein's *Mambo from West Side Story***

Come and Sing

Everyone comes along to watch the concert and gets a chance to perform with the Hallé when we'll all be singing Matthew Gerrard and Robbie Nevil's ***We're All in this Together*** from High School Musical, and Mary Green and Julie Stanley's ***Ai Caramba Samba***.

To book to Come and Sing, fill in Form B on page 4.

Tickets for the concert are just **£3** per person (all pupils and Staff/Adults will need tickets). Each group booking will receive an Information Pack, with links to the learning resources and playlists, so you can prepare to enjoy all the music in the concert.

If you are bringing pupils to both 'Come and Sing' and 'Come and Play' please complete both forms (A and B) to book your tickets.

Meet-a-Musician (Nottinghamshire County Schools only)

All pupils can get to know The Hallé orchestra better by meeting one of its musicians.

A Meet-a-Musician workshop is designed for a class of 30 pupils and involves a visit from a Hallé player, who will demonstrate their instrument and tell the pupils about life as a professional musician. The class will have the opportunity to ask questions, hear the musician perform and take part in a range of musical games and activities. Each workshop lasts for one hour and there will be up to two workshops available per school. A 'Meet-a-Musician' workshop will also contribute towards your students' Arts Award journey.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Do we have to pay for tickets for teachers as well?** Yes, everyone who will be attending the performance will need their own ticket.
- **When will we be able to download learning materials for the concert?**
Once you have booked your tickets, you will be sent a link and a password to download these from the Inspire Nottinghamshire Music Hub web site.
You will also receive a Teacher's Information Pack with all these links and more information about the concert.
- **What time do we need to arrive?** If you are bringing instruments to **Come and Play**, you need to be in the Hall and ready to play in the rehearsal at 12pm, so we advise that you should arrive from 11am.
If you are bringing pupils to **Come and Sing** in the concert, you will need to be in the Hall and in your seats for the start of the concert at 1.00pm, so we advise that you arrive from 12.00pm.
- **What should we all do during the concert?**
Sit quietly and listen to the musicians of the Hallé play and applaud at the end of each piece.
Listen to the presenter when she talks between the pieces
Enjoy your performance when it comes to your turn to Play or Sing.
Stay until the end of the concert and applaud the Hallé to thank them for a great performance.
- **When will Meet-a-Musician happen?**
The Hallé will contact schools who have chosen Meet-a-Musician after we have received your booking form. The Hallé will aim to schedule the workshops in the Summer term before the concert. The timing of the visit will depend on the musicians' availability and the range of dates available in the school's calendar.
- **How do we know where we'll be sitting in the Concert Hall?**
You will be sent a seating plan for your school in June before the concert. **Come and Players** will be sat in the Stalls according to instrument group. So, for example, if you are bringing string players and brass players, they will be sat with other schools' string and brass players. **Come and Singers** will be sat together in their school groups in Tier 1 and Tier 2, above the players.
- **What is the policy for taking photos/filming on the day?** You are only allowed to take photographs/record your own group/school. You can take photos of the Hallé (without a flash), but no filming of the musicians please.
The Hallé may take photographs or video footage of the school children at the Now Hear This concert. Images may be used by the Hallé for publicity and promotion, and on the Hallé's website, Facebook, Instagram and Twitter accounts. Full details will be available in the resources, after booking.
- **What time should we arrange for the buses and coaches to collect us?** The Concert will last around 70 minutes. As it is a live event, it may finish a few minutes later. Your buses and coaches will be able to wait outside the Concert Hall for you.
There is no need to leave the Hall before the end of the concert.
- **When will the Arts Award support materials be available?** The Discover / Explore Arts Award materials will be available for free to any Nottinghamshire County schools. Please contact nottsmusichub@inspireculture.org.uk for more information.
